

Information on the processing of personal data for participants of the Symposium organised by the controller according to the Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on the protection of personal data and the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.

We process your personal data as part of the controller's duties. In the processing personal data by the controller, you are a data subject.

2 Categories of personal data, purpose, and legal basis for the processing of personal data

We process your personal data, namely title, first name, surname, employer's data, and email for the purposes of ensuring the course of the Symposium, registering participants and processing related accounting and tax documents.

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is your voluntarily provided consent, which you confirm by completing and submitting the registration form for the Symposium.

3 Retention period for personal data

The data shall be deleted at the moment when they are no longer necessary to achieve the purpose for which they were recorded. We will process and store the data for the duration of the Symposium. After the Symposium, the personal data may be stored for the necessary time due to contractual or legal obligations, for at least ten years after the end of the Symposium.

4 Recipients

Your personal data within the scope of audiovisual recording (audio recording, videorecording, photographs) may be published in the press and on the controller's website.

5 Source from which the personal data originate

We obtain personal data directly from you when you register for the Symposium or the organization that registered you for the Symposium. We have a database of participants who already participated in symposiums in the past in order to invite them to other events of a similar nature.

6 Transfer of personal data to a third country or international organisation outside the EU

The processing of personal data shall not involve cross-border transfers to third countries.

7 Use of personal data for automated individual decision-making

Personal data will not be used for automated individual decision-making, including profiling.

8 Rights of the data subject

Right to withdraw your consent – you have the right to withdraw your consent if we process your personal data based on your consent.

Right of access – you have the right to request information about what and how personal data about you are being processed.

Right to rectification – you have the right to request the rectification if the personal data we hold is inaccurate, incomplete, or out of date.

Right to erasure – for example, if the personal data we have obtained about you is no longer necessary for the purpose of the processing or you withdraw the consent you have voluntarily provided.

Right to restriction of processing – in certain circumstances, you have the right to request restriction of processing of your personal data.

Right to data portability – in certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to transfer the personal data you have provided to us to a third party.

Right to object – you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, which is based on our legitimate interests. If we do not demonstrate legitimate grounds for the processing, we shall no longer process your personal data.

Right to initiate proceedings for protection of personal data with the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic – if you believe that we process your personal data unlawfully.
